

Black Howler Monkey (*Alouatta pigra*)



Howler monkeys are the loudest animals in the rainforest. They make loud vocalizations to mark their territory, thus earning their name. Their howls - which resemble a strong wind blowing through a tunnel - have been heard over 2 miles away by researchers. Howler monkeys are found only in the rainforests of the Americas.
